Welcome and Introductions	The May 2023 monthly meeting of the Consortium for a Healthier Miami-Dade Children Issues Committee was brought to order by Cristina Brito at 10:05 a.m. All members were welcomed and introduced themselves.	
Approval of Minutes	There was a motion to approve the April 2023 Children Issues minutes by Frantz Theodore, the motion was seconded by Jeff Hurst.	
Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County Swim Safety Presentation	Yoselin Garcia, Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County Epidemiology Department, presented on swim safety and drowning prevention best practices and shared relevant statistics and metrics related to swim safety. Yoselin Garcia is also a drowning prevention champion for a new initiative called the Drowning Prevention Project and in this role is providing prevention materials to multiple organizations. Cristina Brito shared information for the West Kendall Baptist Water Safety Splash Day on May 21 st , 2023. Gilda Ferradaz shared the DCF website for information on child fatalities investigated by the department, including drownings.	
Executive Board Update	Cristina Brito shared that the Consortium Annual Event, which will be celebrating the Consortium’s 20 th Anniversary is anticipated to be on Friday, November 3 rd . She thanked those who have joined the Consortium Event Task Force and noted that anyone interested in joining the Consortium Event Task Force to assist with planning to contact Candice Schottenloher. There will be an opportunity for organizations to sponsor this event and further details pend. She shared that the CDC project officer recently conducted a multi-day site visit. On the first day, at West Perrine and that Cristina and Leyanee presented on the work of all the Consortium Committees to the CDC project officers and DOH Leadership team. On the second day here was also a Showcase with panel presentations and poster presentations.	
Healthy Baby Taskforce Update	The Healthy Baby Taskforce update was provided by Tenesha Avent. The Healthy Baby Taskforce is a sub-committee of the Children Issues committee. The Taskforce last met in April, and they approved the wallet card and palm card designs for the Healthy Baby, Healthy Corner Store initiative. <p>Performance Measures in Need of Improvement</p>	<p>The committee discussed May is National Water Safety Month. The committee reviewed the following work plan activity that needs improvement related to swim and heat safety: By September 30, 2024, the Children Issues Committee will develop an educational awareness campaign on asthma, safety, heat, and sun protection. A reminder was shared the Water Safety Splash Day event on behalf of West Kendall Baptist Hospital will be hosted on Sunday, May 21st, 2023, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. This event was promoted to the full Consortium and next month updates will be shared. Also, West Kendall Baptist Hospital has begun to host their swim safety webinars.</p>	
<p>Recognition of Improved Performance</p>	<p>March of Dimes had a pop-up grocery market experience on March 19th with over 200 attendees. The Black History Month health extravaganza on February 26th was successful. The Ending the HIV Epidemic on February 15th had 300 attendees. Count the Kicks materials were shared in English, Spanish, and Creole.</p>	
<p>New Business</p> <p>Financial Literacy for Middle and High School Students Presentation</p>	<p>Frantz Theodore and Johanne Celestin, Center for Multicultural Wellness and Prevention presented about their program that teaches children financial literacy. This program was funded by the OT21-2103 grant via the Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County and works with middle and high school students. They partner with schools, after school programs, faith-based organizations and many others and the course is taught over 4 sessions. Frantz Theodore is seeking partnership to provide this program to more kids and the program flyer and contact information will be shared.</p>

They provide services for kids with certain medical conditions, such as diabetes, cancer, and other conditions, up to the age of 21. They also provide transportation and have an after-school program. - Healthy Start Coalition of Miami-Dade (HSCMD): Heather Baker shared that their Fatherhood Initiative has officially begun taking referrals. Services are being provided in English and Creole. There are still seeking a Spanish-speaking staff member. The program provides education regarding fathering skills, relationship and communication skills and personal health. On each visit, fathers will receive an incentive such as a \$20 gift card or a gift. Flyers with information will be shared. - BreastfeedMIAMI: KeTia Harris shared that the 12th Annual Breastfeeding Awareness Family Day will be on Saturday August 5th from 10 am to 2pm at Doral Legacy Park. The 3rd Annual Art of Breastfeeding Exhibition will be on Saturday August 26th at 11am-2 pm at Oak Grove Park. A call for artists will be soon to follow.
