Adult living facilities (ALF's) and adult day care providers are not getting reimbursed from Medicaid for some of their residents for up to 2 years. The committee discussed possible reasons and solutions. Suggestion was made that we could try to get Henry Parra involved to begin advocacy for training efforts with the ALF's and day care providers. David and Betty will talk to Max Rothman to initiate advocacy process. There is renewed interest in expansion of Medicaid which will impact Florida seniors. The committee members voted to cancel December's monthly meeting due to the holidays.
